

Apply for a fellowship grant

for the 2018-2019 academic year

OMeGA Medical Grants Association fellowship grants support clinical fellowship programs in all nine orthopaedic subspecialty categories. Grants (up to \$75,000) may be used for fellow's salary and benefits. (Request preapproval of other direct educational expenses if salary and benefit support is not possible.)

OMeGA supports fellowship programs that advance musculoskeletal healthcare

Of the 2017-2018 AY OMeGA grant recipients across all subspecialties:

- 92 percent were affiliated with an accredited residency program
- 95 percent participated in the Fellowship Match process
- 65 percent of OMeGA applicants received grants
- 91 percent of the programs were in the U.S.; 9 percent were in Canada

Across all subspecialties for the first six months of the 2016-17 academic year, OMeGA fellows:

- Participated in 256 research projects
- Took part in 262 local presentations and 27 national/international presentations
- Contributed to 34 publications

Assessment criteria

Applications are rated based on criteria such as:

- Faculty qualification and expertise
- Fellowship match information
