

Apply for a fellowship grant

for the 2019-2020 academic year

OMeGA Medical Grants Association fellowship grants support US fellowship programs in all nine orthopaedic subspecialty categories. Grants of up to \$75,000 may be used for a fellow's salary and benefits. Preapproval for other direct educational expenses must be requested during the application process.

OMeGA supports fellowship programs that advance musculoskeletal healthcare

Of the 2018-2019 academic year OMeGA grant recipients across all subspecialties:

- 92% were affiliated with an accredited residency program
- 98% of US programs participated in the Fellowship Match process
- 68% of OMeGA applicants received grants

In the first six months of the 2017-2018 academic year, OMeGA fellows:

- Participated in 329 research projects
- Took part in 288 local presentations and 22 national/international presentations
- Contributed to 24 publications

Assessment criteria

Applications are rated based on criteria such as:

- Faculty qualification and expertise
- Fellowship match information
- Broad look at the program's diversity over the past five years
- Method of formal evaluation of faculty, fellows, and fellowship program
- Program's environment of research
- Procedures performed and CPT codes reported in each subspecialty
