

Apply for a residency/general educational grant

Application period opens February 25

OMeGA Medical Grants Association will be accepting applications for the 2013-2014 academic year starting Monday, February 25. Orthopaedic residency programs may apply for a grant up to \$5,000. Educational items include but are not limited to:

- Books and journals for program use (hard copy or electronic)
- Educational courses, including online courses, self-assessment courses, and other learning aids
- Journal club support (not to conflict with JBJS program)
- Development of novel curricula and/or educational resources
- Skills Lab
- Cadaver sessions
- Visiting professors/Grand Rounds speakers

Applications with a broader benefit to the residency program are given special consideration.

Applications are reviewed by the non-conflicted OMeGA board members. Grants are awarded based on objective criteria, including:

- How requested funds improve the learning experience for the residents
- Merits of the educational program
- Faculty expertise
- Program accreditation status
- Educational resources

Residency/general education applications will be accepted through Friday, May 3, 2013, 5pm CDT
