

Apply for a residency/general educational grant

Application period opens January 27

OMeGA Medical Grants Association will be accepting applications for the 2014-2015 academic year starting Monday, January 27. Note: this schedule is 4 weeks earlier than in past years in response to applicant programs that have requested earlier grant notification.

Orthopaedic residency programs may apply for a grant up to \$5,000. Educational items include but are not limited to:

- Books and journals for program use (hard copy or electronic)
- Educational courses, including online and self-assessment courses
- Journal club support (not to conflict with JBJS program)
- Development of novel curricula
- Skills Lab
- Cadaver sessions

Applications with a broader benefit to the residency program are given special consideration. Applications are reviewed by the non-conflicted OMeGA reviewers. Grants are awarded based on objective criteria, including:

- How requested funds improve the learning experience for the residents
- Merits of the educational program
- Faculty expertise
- Program accreditation status

Residency/general education applications will be accepted through Friday, March 21, 2014, 5pm CDT
